**Dial-A-Ride**: Curb-to-curb service with handicap-accessible vehicles, available 6am-9pm Monday – Saturday. The one-way fare for Dial-A-Ride riders is \$5 for all of Erie County, and \$3 to, from or within the City of Vermillion and within a 10-mile radius of Vermillion. Children 5 and under ride for free. Reduced fares are available for persons 65 and older or with a qualifying disability. To schedule a ride with Dial-A-Ride, call at least 48 hours in advance of the time you want to be picked up. Reservations are taken 8am-4pm Monday -Friday. Reservations can be taken up to two weeks in advance.
