Basic Information about What is Title I?

- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help low achieving students or students who are at risk of falling behind
- Federal funding is allocated to schools based on the number of students in the school receiving free or reduced priced lunches

A summary of the current Schoolwide Assistance Program at TCS

- What is a Schoolwide Title I program?
 - Schools where at least 40% of students are eligible to receive free or reduced priced lunches are eligible to offer schoolwide Title I programs. Title I funds are used to upgrade the entire educational program of the school and serve all students in the school to raise academic achievement.
- Funding of the salary of 1 general education teacher to achieve explicit vocabulary instruction and other ELA goals
- Reach for Success program transitioned out of Title I in 2022-2023
- Looking to fund tutors through this program following the end of ESSER funding
- Professional development focused around math and English development strategies

 - Address learning gaps based on achievement data from state testing scores
 - Provide necessary structures and supports equitable to all students
 - Provide career and college readiness support to help students achieve their goals academically which will allow them to achieve their future life goals

 - We will select and implement a program to support vocabulary instruction.
 - We will offer support to students and parents to educate them on how to access their local library and obtain a library card.
 - We will provide a literacy night for students and their families.
 - We will implement the Zearn program to support Math remediation.
 - We will provide staff with ELA and/or Math professional development.
